Once again we are celebrating our beautiful mountain top community, perfect weather and friendly people. Come join us! We are inviting vendors to be a part of our very exciting day starting with a parade at 10AM. Vendors are ready to go by 9AM.

This year we are planning a return of our popular Beer Garden which will be serving beer, wine, soft drinks and food. Find comfortable places to sit, listen or dance to the music of returning - featured bands; Tripwire, Bill Dutcher, Chad Freeman and Redline. Artistic and creative vendors will be presenting their wares and sharing valuable information to our visitors.

### ***Don't miss out!***

Vendors are asked to set up before 9AM and remain until 4PM. Spaces are approximately 10' x 10' or 12x12. A non-refundable donation for each space is \$15 for local vendors, \$30 for out of town vendors, and all food vendors are \$45. Checks are made payable to Yarnell-Peeples Valley Chamber of Commerce. Spaces will be assigned on a first paid basis. Make a note on the application if you want to be next to someone or if you have made special arrangements with a business in town. If you are a returning vendor indicate if you want the same space or a change. There is no water at the vendor sites and electricity is very limited. An extra charge of \$10 is applied for electric use.

All vendors will need to supply their own tables, canopies, equipment, tie downs, and etc. **Vendors are responsible for permits, licensing, tax collections and insurance.**

**FOOD VENDORS:** if you are selling or giving away food you are responsible for permits and licensing with YAVAPAI COUNTY HEALTH. If you do not have appropriate permits you will not be allowed to set up. **Please send a copy of your permit to address below as soon as available in advance of event.** Our inspector insists on 3 sides being covered for food booths.

**FEE:** Each 10'x10' or 12x12 space is \$15 for local (Yarnell/Peeples Valley), \$30 for out-of-town vendors and \$45 for all food vendors. This is a **Non-Refundable Donation**. Spaces will be outdoors and have no water. Electricity is limited and a \$10 fee will be charged. Exhibitor is responsible to provide own equipment (pop up, chairs, tables, water, etc)

**SET UP:** \*\*\*\*Vendors are expected to be checked in and set up by 9 a.m. and remain until 4 PM. on the day of the event.

**PERMITS:** All food vendors must have Yavapai Co. "Special Event Food Vendor License Application" (SEFVLA) and Food Handlers Card regardless of non-profit status, food being sold or given away. Must have 3 sides enclosed.

Use Yarnell Daze for Name of Event and Trish Edwards for Event Sponsor.

If you do not have the applicable license displayed, and **sent to me before event, you will not be permitted to participate. Inspectors will be present.**

**IMPORTANT:** this is a family event and the Yarnell Daze committee holds the right to refuse any applicants of a questionable nature. No alcohol, drug related or X-rated items are to be sold or exhibited. Spaces will be assigned on a first-come-first-paid basis. Event will take place regardless of weather conditions.

By signing the waiver and applying for a vendor space, "I acknowledge all responsibility for permits, tax collection, safety of property, persons and equipment while participating in the event. I understand that I shall hold Yarnell Daze, Yarnell-Peeples Valley Chamber of Commerce, or the communities of Yarnell-Peeples Valley or the property owner, harmless and release from any and all liability arising from actions or claims that may be brought against the vendor, injury or property damage arising from an accident occasioned by an employee or entrant of mine."

## Arts and Crafts and FOOD Vendor Release Insurance Waiver Yarnell Daze May 13, 2017 A Mountaintop Festival

By virtue of your voluntary participation in the Yarnell Daze event offered by Yarnell – Peeples Valley Chamber of Commerce said participant understands, acknowledges, represents, warrants and agrees as follows, with the knowledge that the Chamber and Company will rely on same:

1. Participant desires to participate in the Yarnell Daze Festival event offered by the Chamber.
2. Participant fully comprehends and accepts all of the risks associated with his/her participation in the event including, without limitation, exposure to unfavorable weather conditions, injuries without limitation, those arising out of self-inflicted accidents or mishaps, other participants, automobiles, pedestrians and the like and death.
3. Participant is in good health and suffers from no minor or serious physical or mental injury, illness or disability that would make Participant especially susceptible to injury or disability while performing any activity contemplated by this Waiver and Release of Claims.
4. Participant's participation in the event is at participant's own sole risk. Participant, on behalf of his/herself and/or any person or entity acting through or on behalf of participant, hereby forever and unconditionally releases the company, and all affiliated entities, present and former employees, owners, officers, members, managers, partners, contractors, insurers and directors of the foregoing from any and all claims, actions, damages, liabilities, losses, costs, and expenses in any way arising out of, or resulting from, participant's participation in the event, including, without limitation, any and all claims, actions, and liabilities for death, injury, loss or damage to participant, to anyone else, or to any property, regardless of whether or not such injury, loss or damage was caused by the negligence or willful conduct of the company or any of the released parties, participant, on behalf of his/herself and/or any person or entity acting through or on behalf of participant.
5. This Waiver and Release of Claims constitutes the entire agreement and understanding between Participant and the Released Parties, and cancels, terminates and supersedes any prior agreement or understanding relating to the subject matter hereof. There are no representations, promises, agreements, warranties, covenants, or undertakings other than those contained in this Waiver and Release of Claims.
6. Participant hereby releases and agrees to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the Chamber from, for and against any and all liabilities, suits, claims, damages, injuries, actions, costs or expenses of any kind or nature whatsoever, due to or arising out of the use of the event fairgrounds, wherever they may be located during the course of this event, or out of any act, negligence, or neglect of Participant, its employees, guests, servants, volunteers, agents or invitees. The indemnities of Participant under this item shall survive the expiration or earlier termination of this Agreement.
7. None of the provisions of this Waiver and Release of Claims can be waived or modified except expressly in writing signed by Participant and the party against whom the waiver or modification is sought to be enforced. Failure of any of the Released Parties to enforce any of their rights hereunder at any time shall not act as a waiver to enforce their rights under this Waiver and Release for same or similar acts at any subsequent time.
8. The Participant shall, at the time of the execution of this Agreement, obtain at its own cost and expense a Certificate of liability insurance including, but not limited to, the following coverage:
9. **COMMERCIAL GENERAL LIABILITY-Premises/operations, products/completed operations, contractual, personal injury, broad form property damage and fire legal liability using these limits: \$1,000,000.00/Per Occurrence for Bodily Injury and Property Damage. \$2,000,000.00 Aggregate.-----if you are a commercial entity or have a tax id #.**
